

# SOVIK CUP POINT SYSTEM

The Sovik Cup Team is made up of the top ten players in the standings after the NYS Sr. Amateur is played. A player who wins a tournament is automatically on the team for that year no matter how many points he has accumulated. If there were different winners, then there would be 6 spots open based solely on points earned.

## **SDGA Senior - Post Standard Senior – Sr. Match Play Qualifying Round**

Points are awarded to the top 20 players and ties for each of the 2 rounds in each tournament. The top 20 players in the final standings of the SDGA Sr. and the Post Standard S receive bonus points. The Match Play qualifying round is considered a 1<sup>st</sup> round as far as points are concerned.

The point allotment is as follows:

For example: If a player was 11<sup>th</sup> in the first round, 3<sup>rd</sup> in the second, and 6<sup>th</sup> in the final results, he would receive a total of 58 points. A 3-way tie for second in any round would split 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> points.

## **Syracuse Senior Match Play**

Points are awarded as follows: These points are over and above the points for the qualifying round.

20 points for each match won in the Championship Flight

15 points for each match won in the 1st Flight

10 points for each match won in the 2nd Flight

5 points for each match won in the 3rd Flight

## **NY State Senior Am**

Points are awarded based on the final standings only. 1<sup>st</sup> place is worth 100 points. The value decreases by 5 points for each lower spot, so if you finished 20<sup>th</sup>, you would receive 5 points.

50 points are also awarded for qualifying for major national amateur events.
